General work description:

The work to be done includes, but is not limited to the following: sawcut, cold-planing existing asphalt concrete, proof-roll/ compact exposed base, hot mix asphalt concrete, demolition and reconstruction of existing gutters and curb and gutters and sidewalks and curb ramps, installation of new lamphole monument covers, raising of existing manhole and water valve covers, and other items of or details not mentioned above, that are required by typical construction, Standard Specifications or these special provisions.

A Pre-Bid Meeting is scheduled for **April 8, 2019 at 10:00 AM**, at WASCO City Hall, 746 8th Street, WASCO, California. This meeting is to inform bidders of project requirements. Bidder's attendance at this meeting will not be mandatory.

Bids are required for the entire work described herein.

Bids **must** be submitted on the Bid Proposal form provided by the City of Wasco. Each bid must be accompanied by one of the following forms of bidder's security in the amount of ten percent (10%) of the amount bid: (1) cash; (2) a cashier's check made payable to the City of Wasco; (3) a certified check made payable to the City of Wasco; or (4) a bidder's bond executed by an admitted surety insurer, made payable to the City of Wasco. The contractor shall possess a City Business License and a Class "A" license at the time this contract is awarded.

No contractor or subcontractor may be listed on a bid proposal or awarded a contract for a public works project unless registered with the Department of Industrial Relations pursuant to Labor Code Sec. 1725.5. This project is subject to compliance monitoring and enforcement by the Department of Industrial Relations.

Inquiries or questions based on alleged patent ambiguity of the plans, specifications or estimate must be communicated as a bidder inquiry prior to bid opening. Any such inquiries or questions, submitted after bid opening, will not be treated as a bid protest. Technical questions should be directed to Mr. Kameron Arnold, telephone (661) 758-7204.
