We appreciate your patience during this challenging and rapidly changing time. This is an **update to building inspection services** being provided by the City of Wasco during our current COVID-19 closure.

If you have an existing open building permit, the City will be providing building inspections services as follows:

Residential Inspections – Tuesdays Only

Inspections on open residential building permits including residential solar permits will be made on **Tuesdays only. To schedule an inspection, please call Rafael Villareal at 661-699-9463** by no later than 5:00pm the Monday before you wish to schedule a Tuesday inspection. Please leave your name, the address and permit number of the job being inspected on his voicemail. You will not receive a confirmation call.

Commercial Inspections – Thursdays Only

Inspections on open commercial building permits will be made on **Thursdays only. To schedule an inspection, please call Marlo Glaser at 661-758-7225** by the Wednesday before you wish to schedule the inspection. Please leave your name, the address and permit number of the job being inspected on his voicemail. You will not receive a confirmation call.

For your safety and the safety of our inspectors, our inspectors will not enter any occupied structures and will be practicing social distancing. Interior inspections in occupied structures may be made remotely via digital technology. Please arrange this with your inspector in advance if you have an interior inspection in an occupied structure that needs to be made.
